with the Texas Law Enforcement Analysis Portal (LEAP)**

Ann Arbor, Michigan, September 14, 2010 – EJustice Solutions is pleased to announce our alliance with the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) to provide an automated interface to the Law Enforcement Analysis Portal (LEAP) data sharing initiative. The interface between the two applications provides for the seamless flow of incident information into the LEAP system making the information available for cross jurisdictional information sharing and analysis of crime patterns.

The value of information sharing to law enforcement is critical to effectively solving and preventing crime. With funding and technical constraints many law enforcement agencies do not have the ability to standardize the electronic capture and sharing of information.
